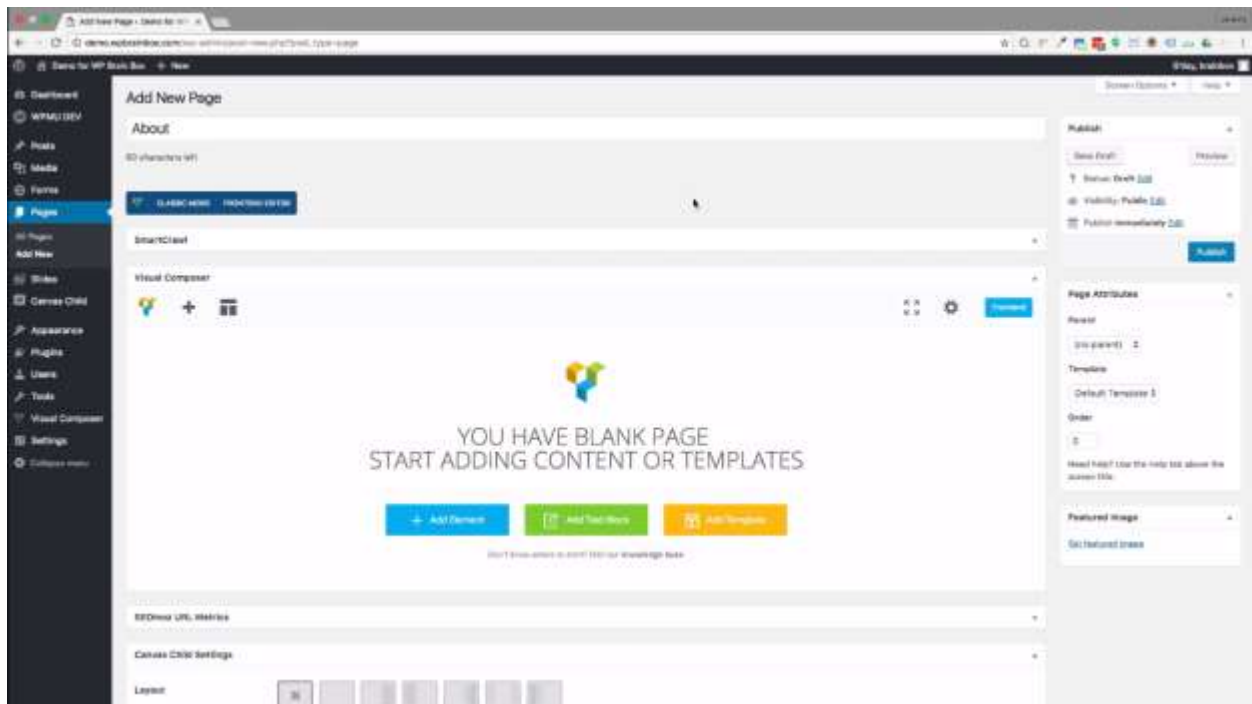


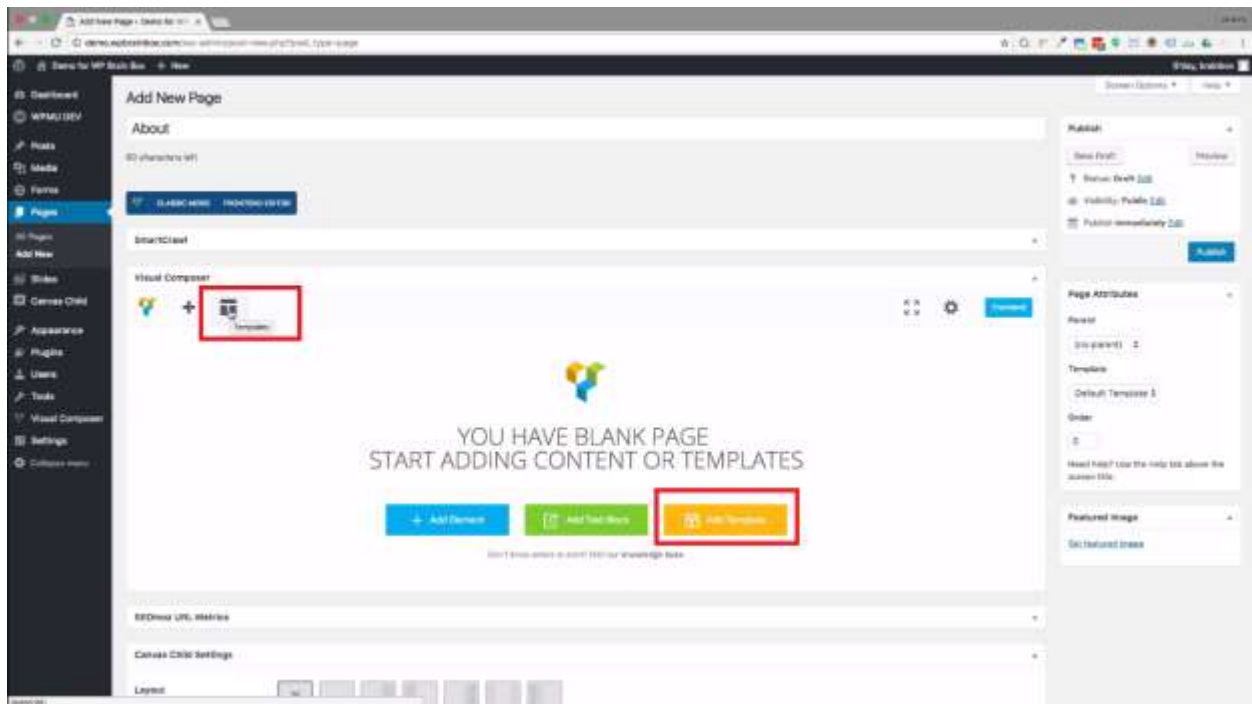
How to add a default Visual Composer Template to a new page?



When you're starting a new page, sometimes it'll be a bit daunting because it's just a blank space. We're going to make up rows and columns and put a lot of content in. So, if you want to have a bit of a head start and you're not really sure how to layout the page, there's a great little tool called Visual Composer Default Templates.

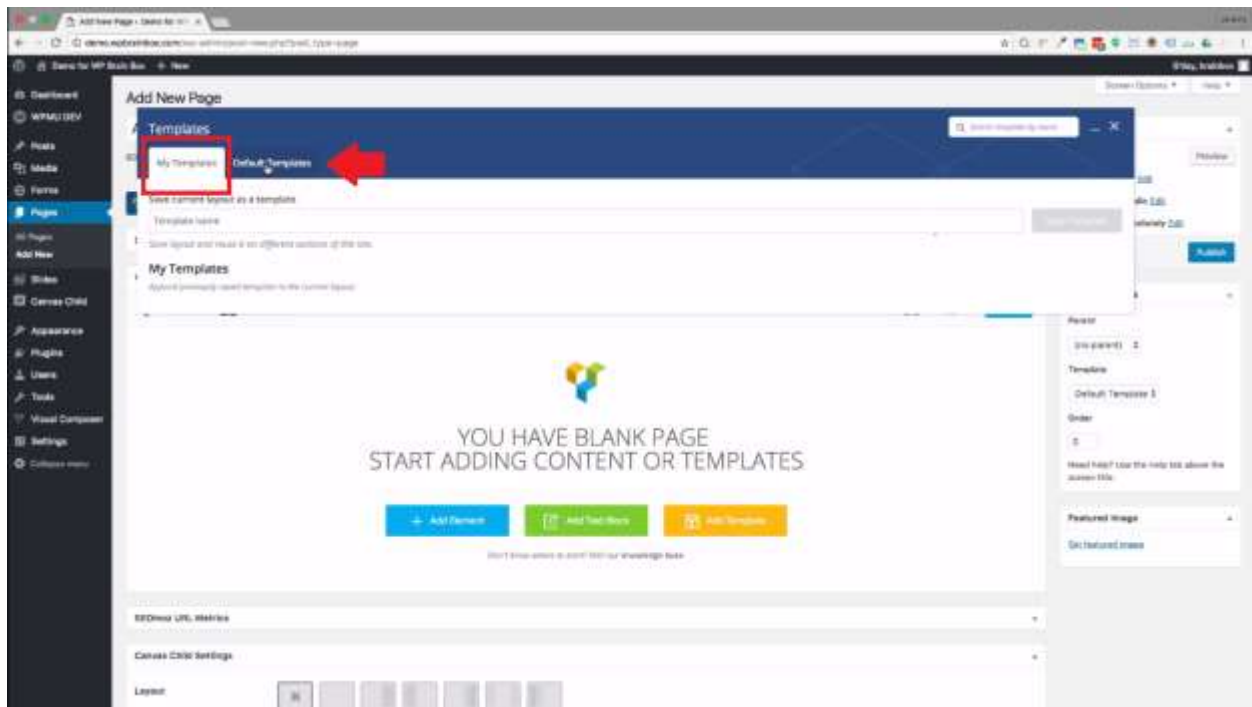
The following are the steps on how to use the Visual Composer Default Templates:

Click on the icon where it says templates



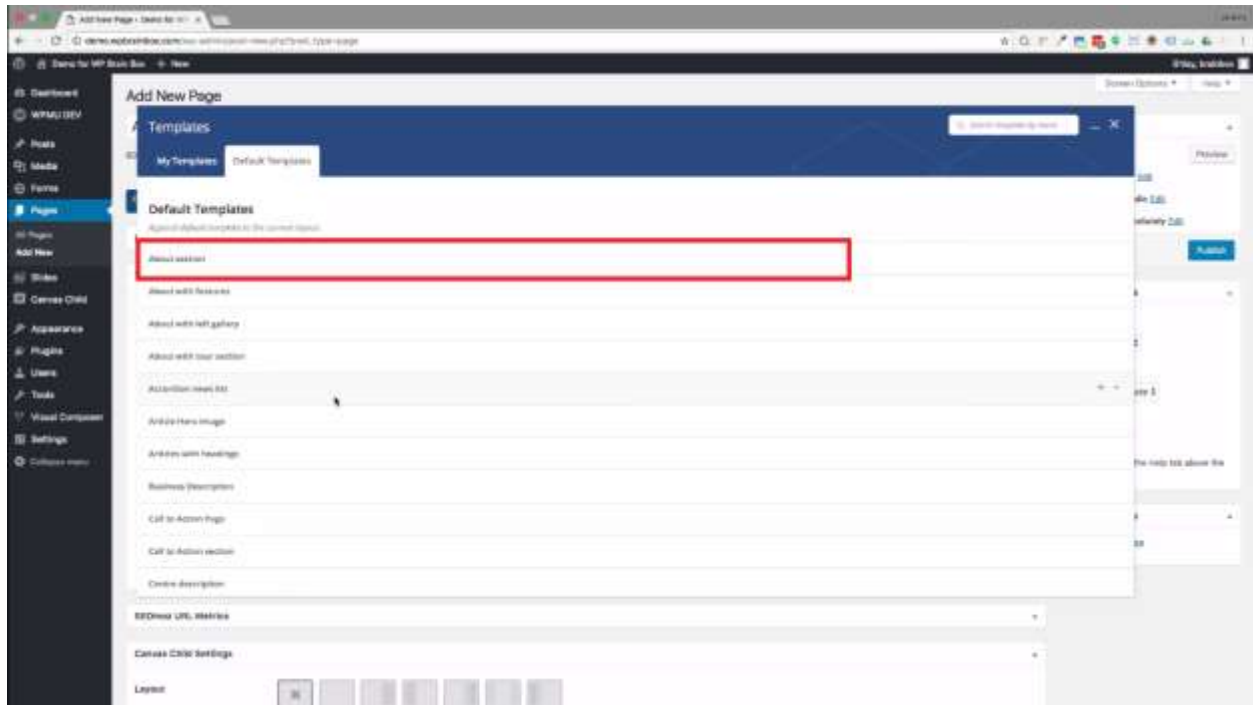
First, in order for the templates to show, you will need to click either of the buttons. These buttons are enclosed in a red box for emphasis.

Click on the Default Templates tab



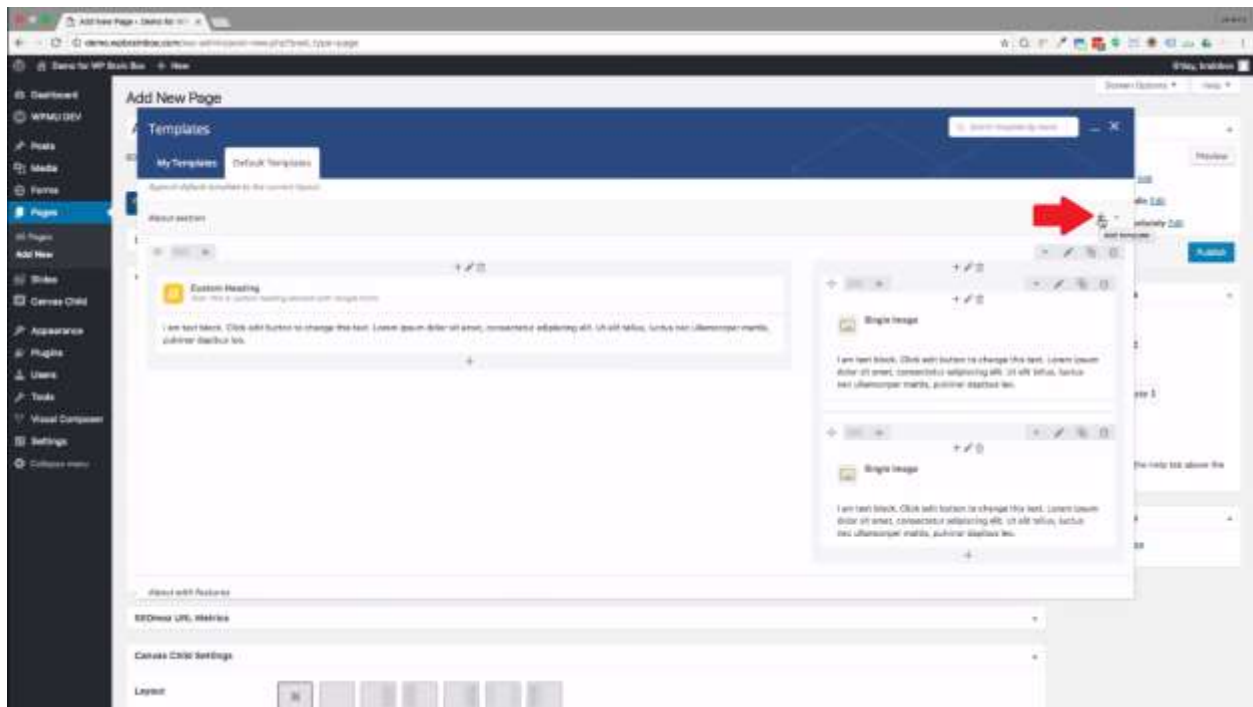
Next, click the Default Items tab beside the My Templates tab.

The Default Templates tab



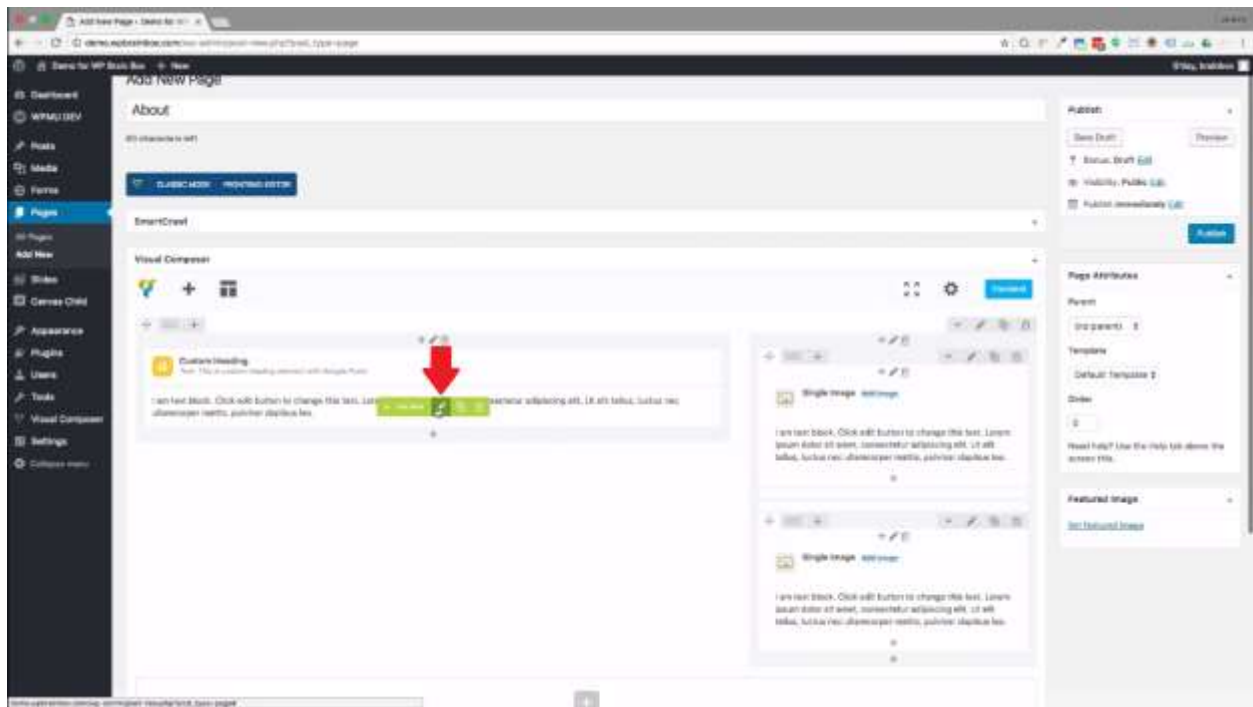
After clicking the Default Templates tab, a list of all the default templates will be seen. Next, if you click on the About Section template, a template with 2 columns will be seen.

Click on the '+' icon to use this template



If you want to use this template, click the '+' icon.

Click on the pencil icon to edit the column



Lastly, if you want to start editing this template, you can hover your mouse to the selected division and a green option will appear. Click on the pencil icon to start editing.

That's it. With this default templates from Visual Composer Default Templates, laying out your page will never be hard.
