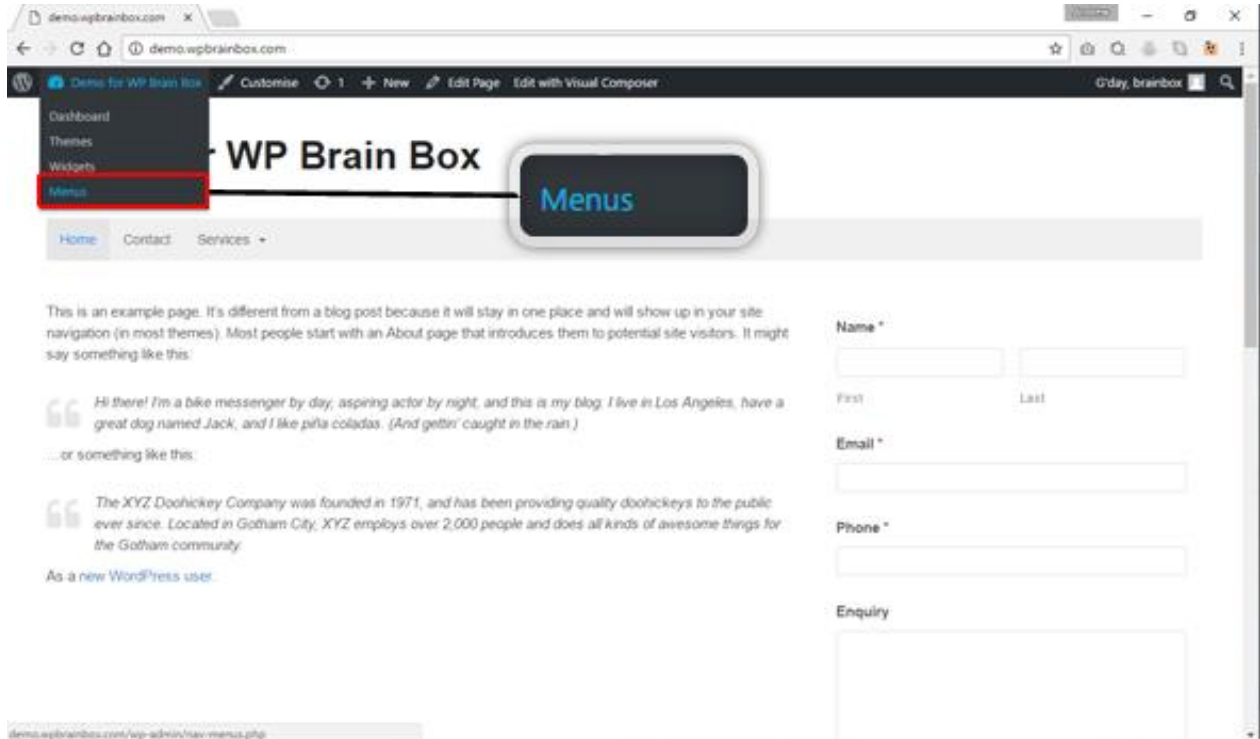


ADD A PAGE TO THE MAIN MENU

When you create a new page, it doesn't necessarily add to the menu. The following are the steps on how to add your page to the main menu:

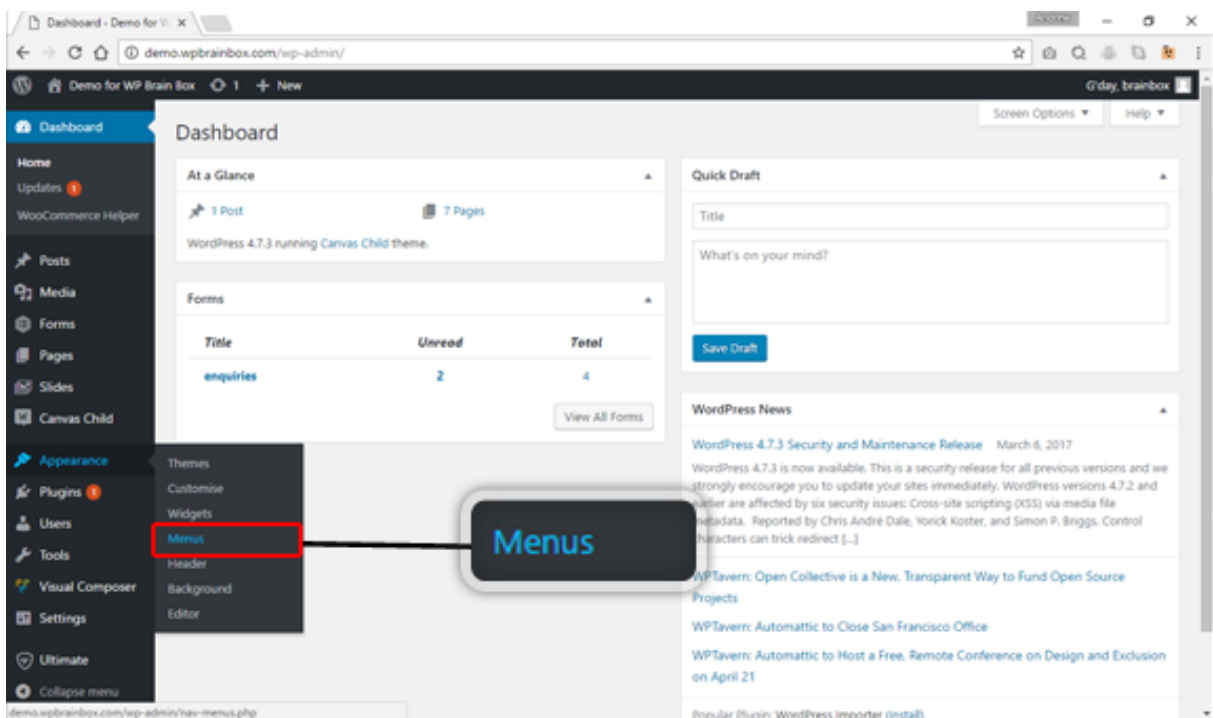
Step 1: Go to the **Menus** page



Hover your mouse on the drop-down menu and choose **Menus**.

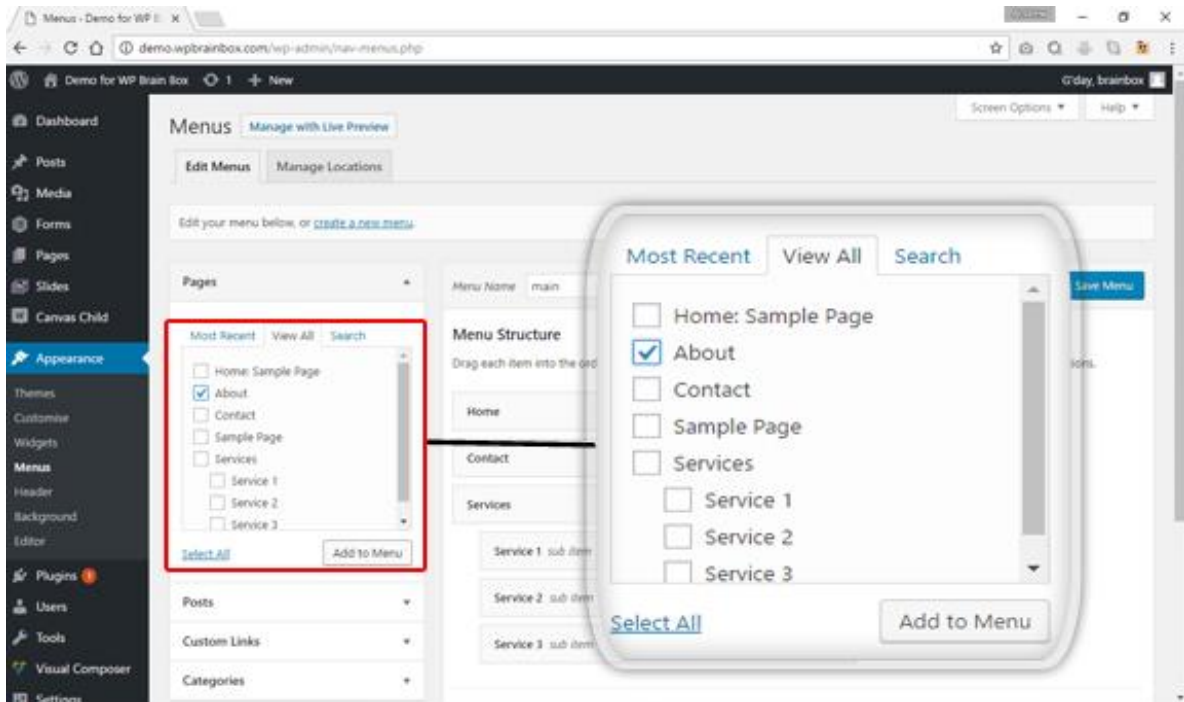
OR

Step 1: Choose **Menus** from **Appearance**



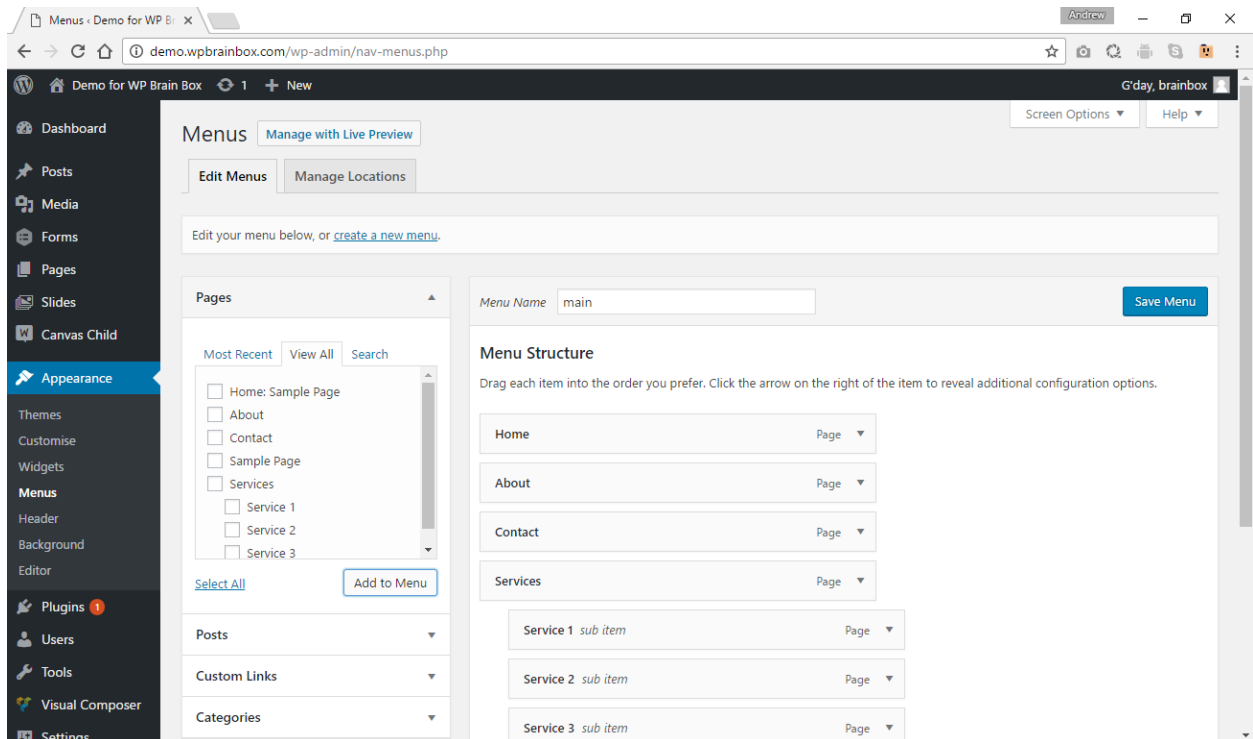
If you are on your dashboard, click/hover **Appearance** and then choose **Menus**.

Step 2: Select the page and click on **Add in Menu**



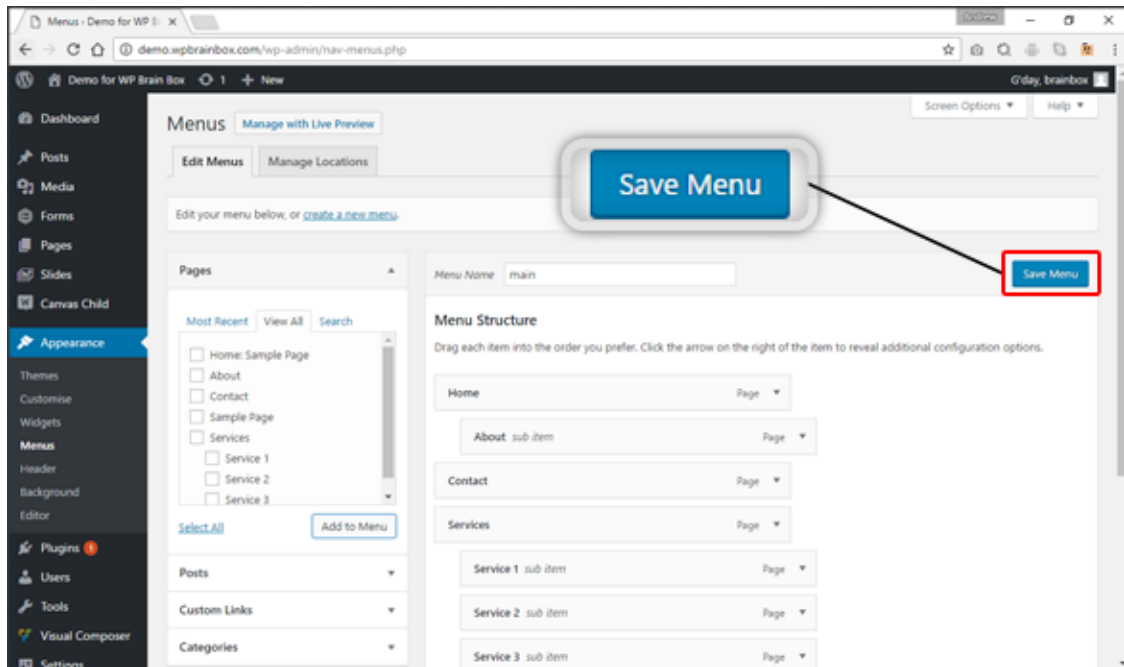
Click **View All** to show all the pages you've created. Afterwards, select at least one page you want to be added to the main menu the click **Add to Menu** button.

Step 3: Set the structure of your menu



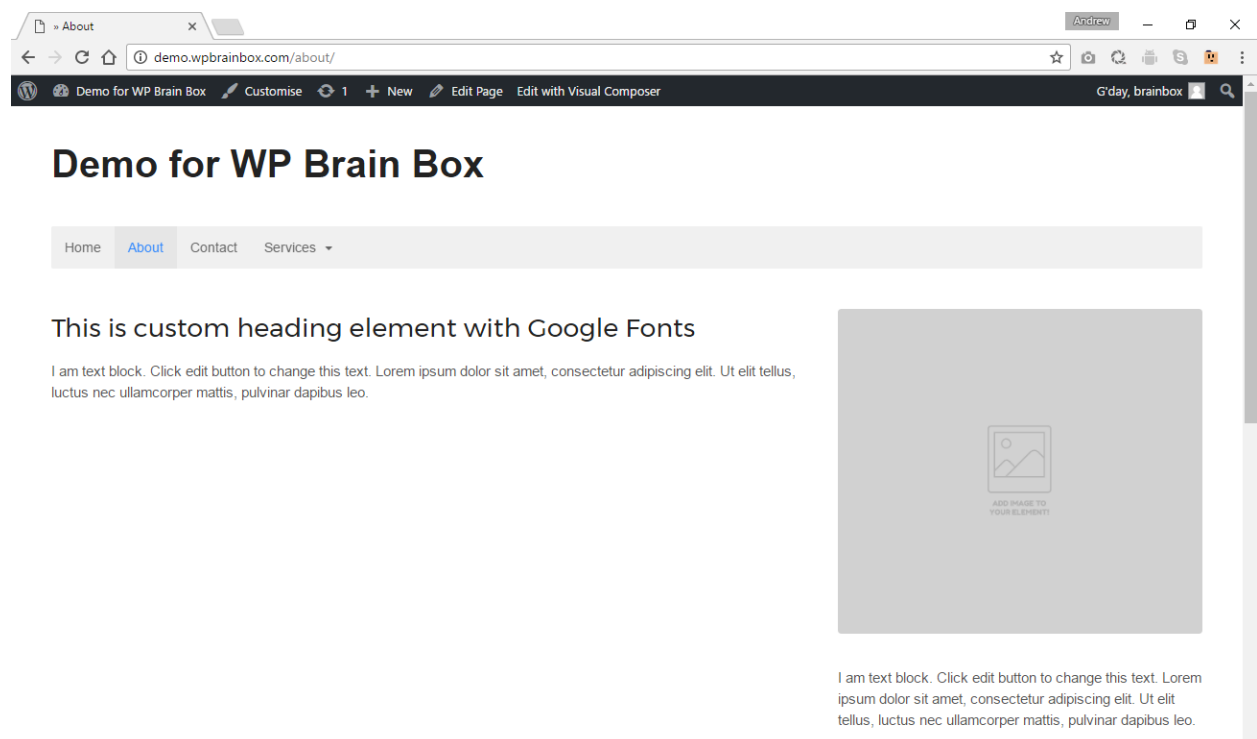
After clicking the **Add to Menu**, it will be added to the **Menu Structure**. You can now freely reorder your pages by dragging them up and down.

Step 4: Save your Menu



If you're already satisfied ordering your menu, click the blue-colored **Save Menu** button. Both buttons work fine.

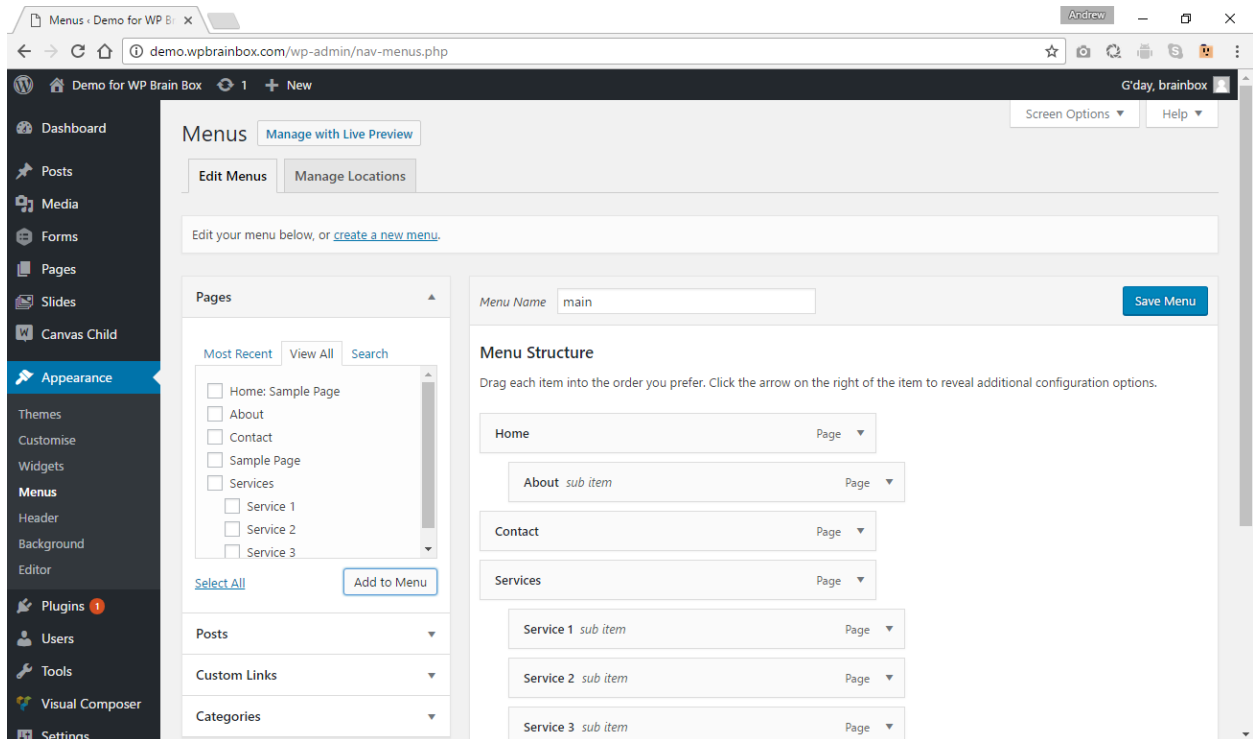

To check if my menus were already added, I'll go back to my homepage. As you can see in the image above, the 'About' menu already appeared.

The important thing to remember, adding a page does not automatically add the page to the menu. Once you've created your page, you have to add it yourself to the menus.

TIPS:



You can also make it as a sub item by dragging it to the right under the page you want it to belong. In the image above, we made **About** as the subpage of **Home**.
