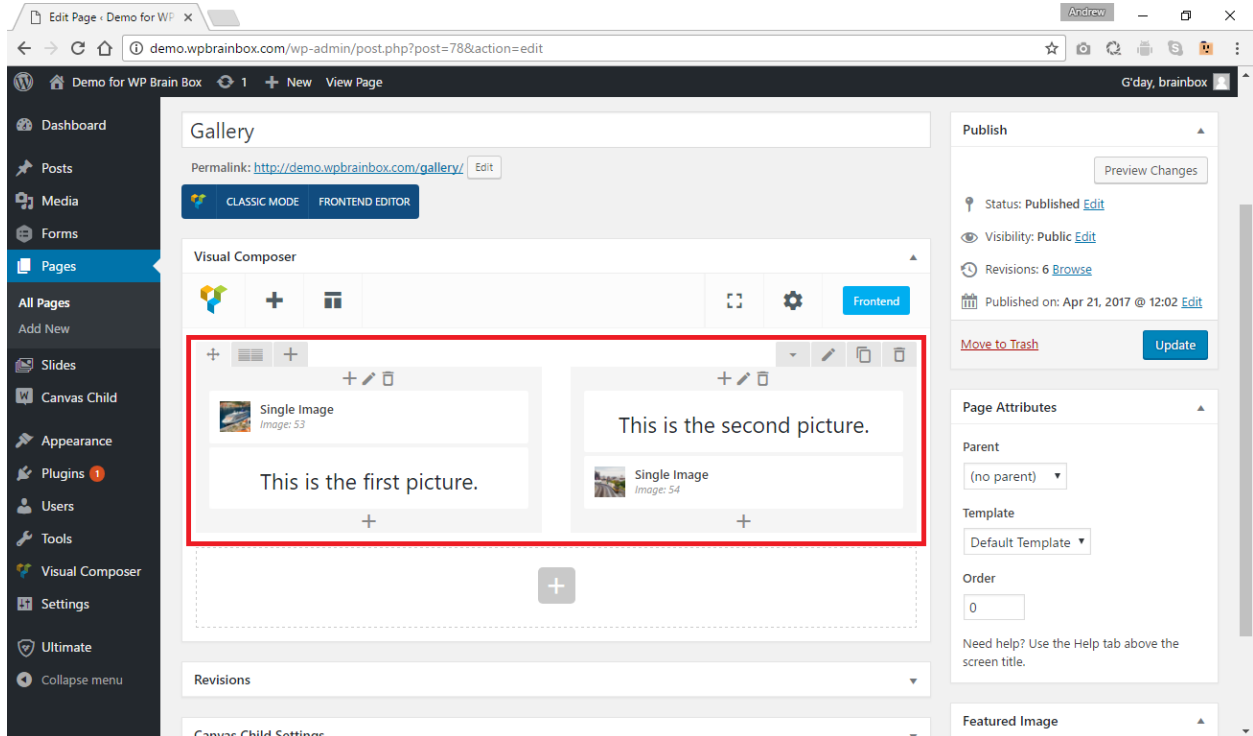


REARRANGE COLUMNS AND ELEMENTS WITH VISUAL COMPOSER

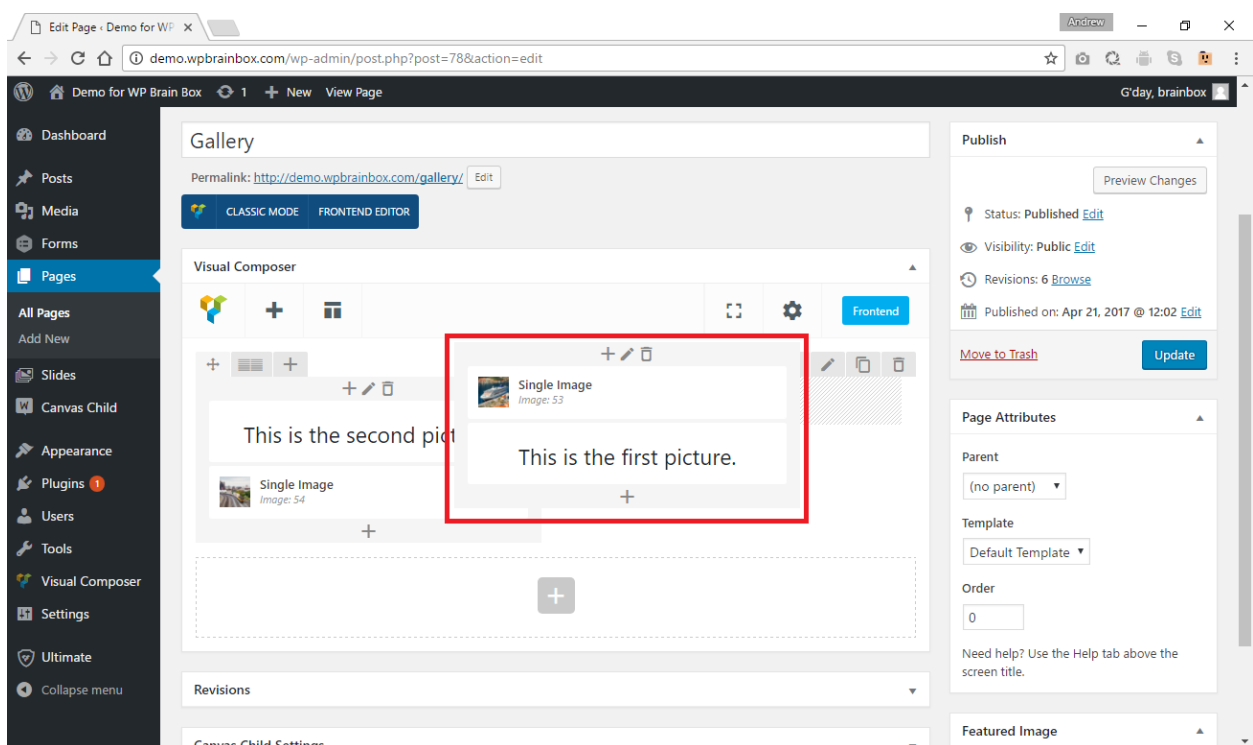
Rearranging the elements in rows and column in Visual Composer is one of the excellent features which makes reconfiguring the layout of a page in the simplest way by just dragging the element to the column or row you want in to belong.



Let's have this page as an example. This page got two columns and each column consist of two elements in it. The current layout of the row in $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2}$ structure.

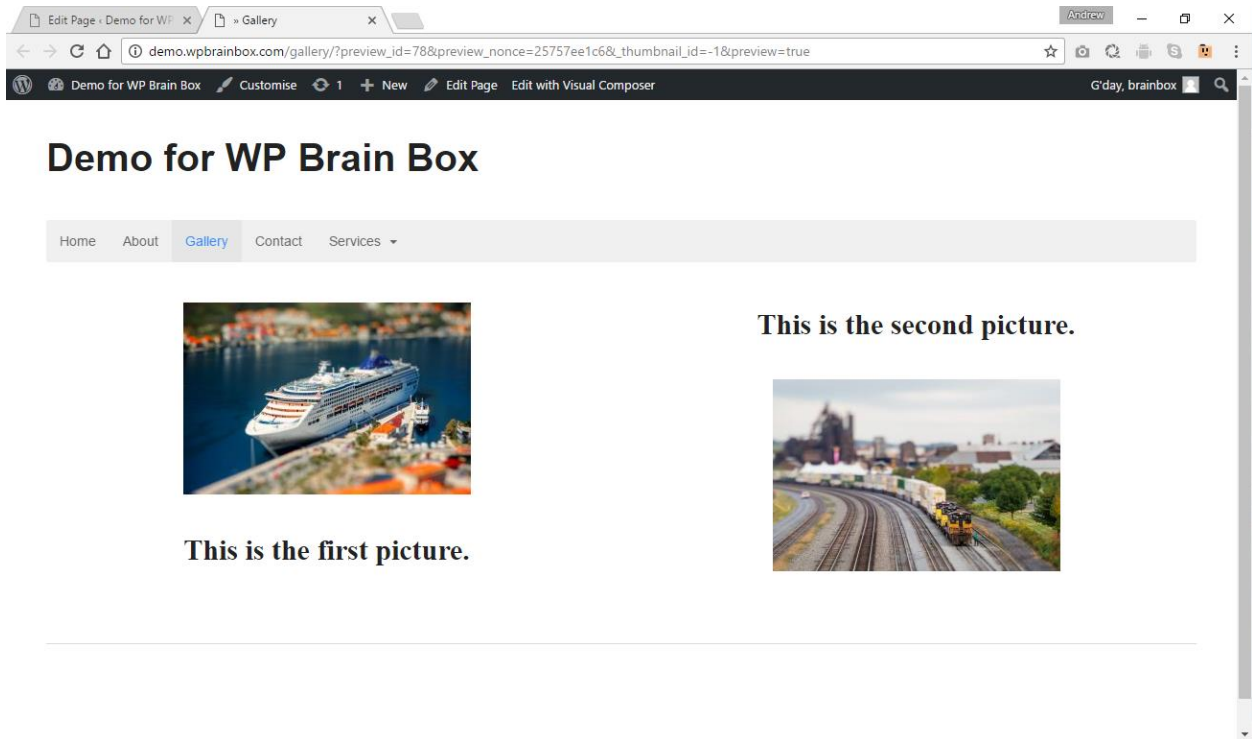

Step 1: Rearrange the column



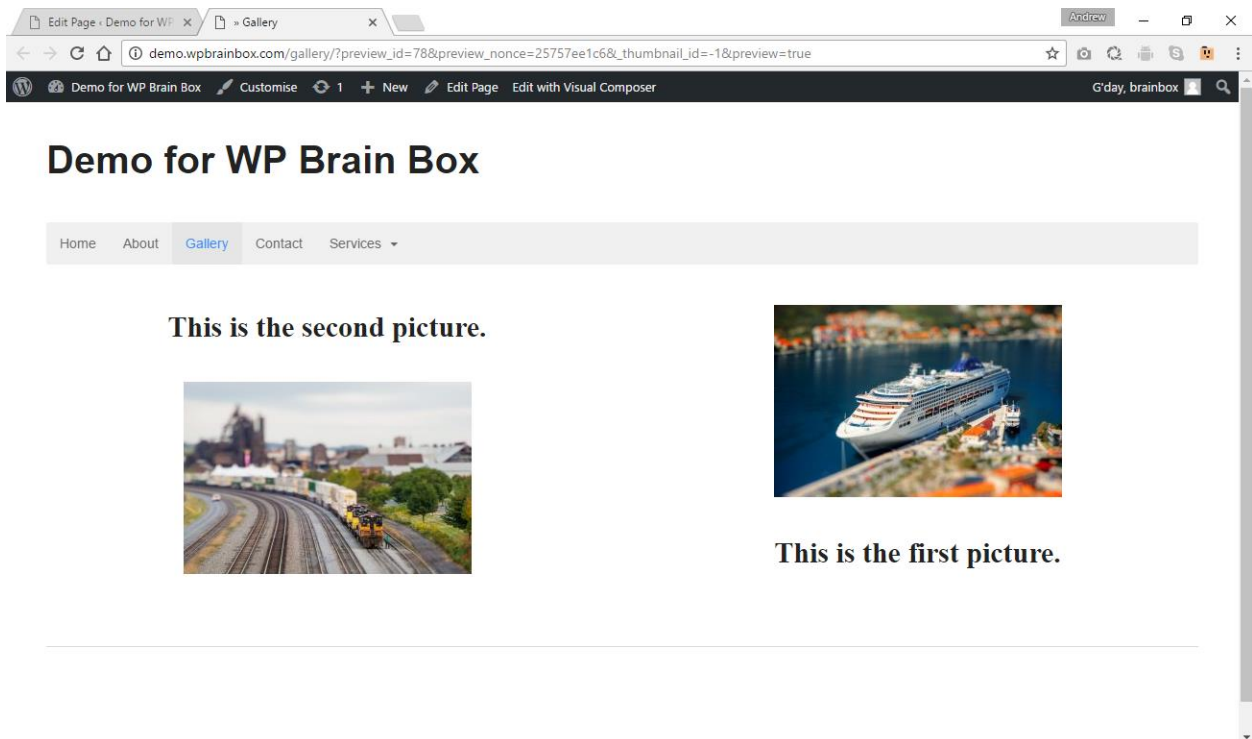
Let's rearrange this page by interchanging the first column to the second column. To do that, we need to drag the first column to the second column. This will automatically put the second column to the first one. Then click preview to see the changes.

Before Editing



This is what it looks like before we interchange the two columns.

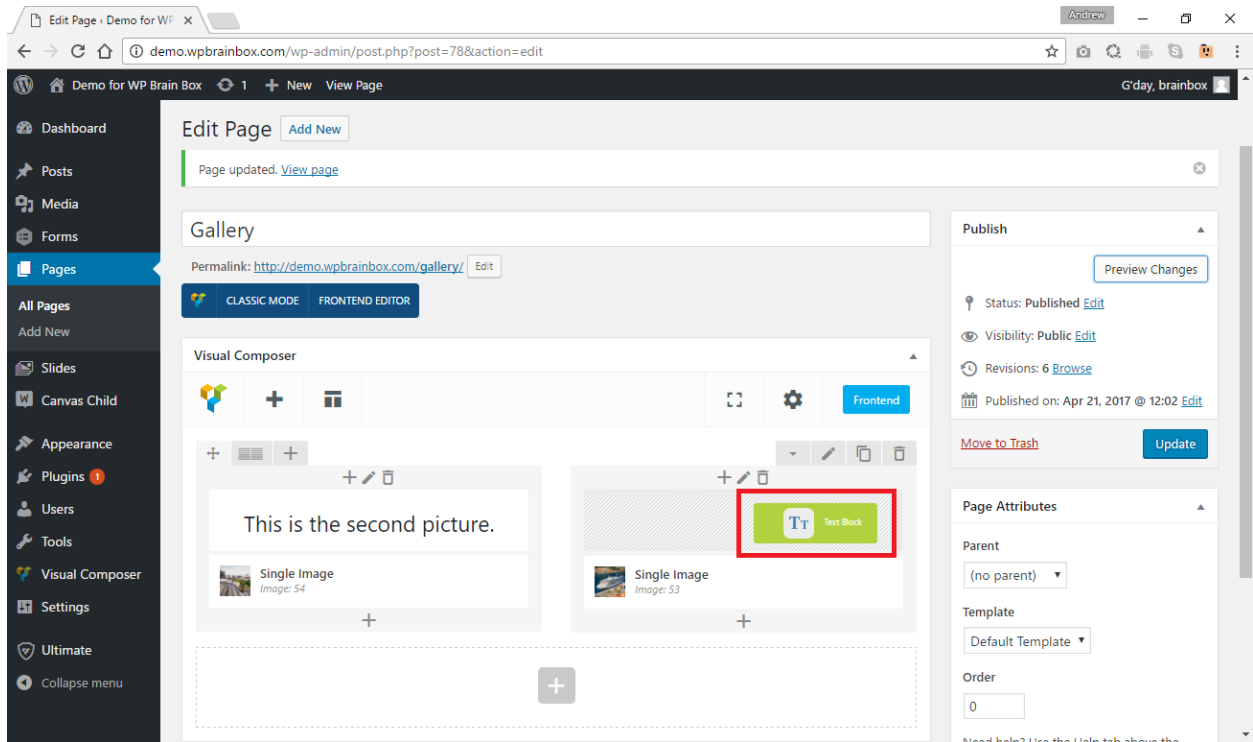
After Editing



After editing, you can see now that the columns are already interchange. The neat part about this is that you don't have to do any recoding. You can just move the columns to where you want to go. The same is true for the elements on the page.

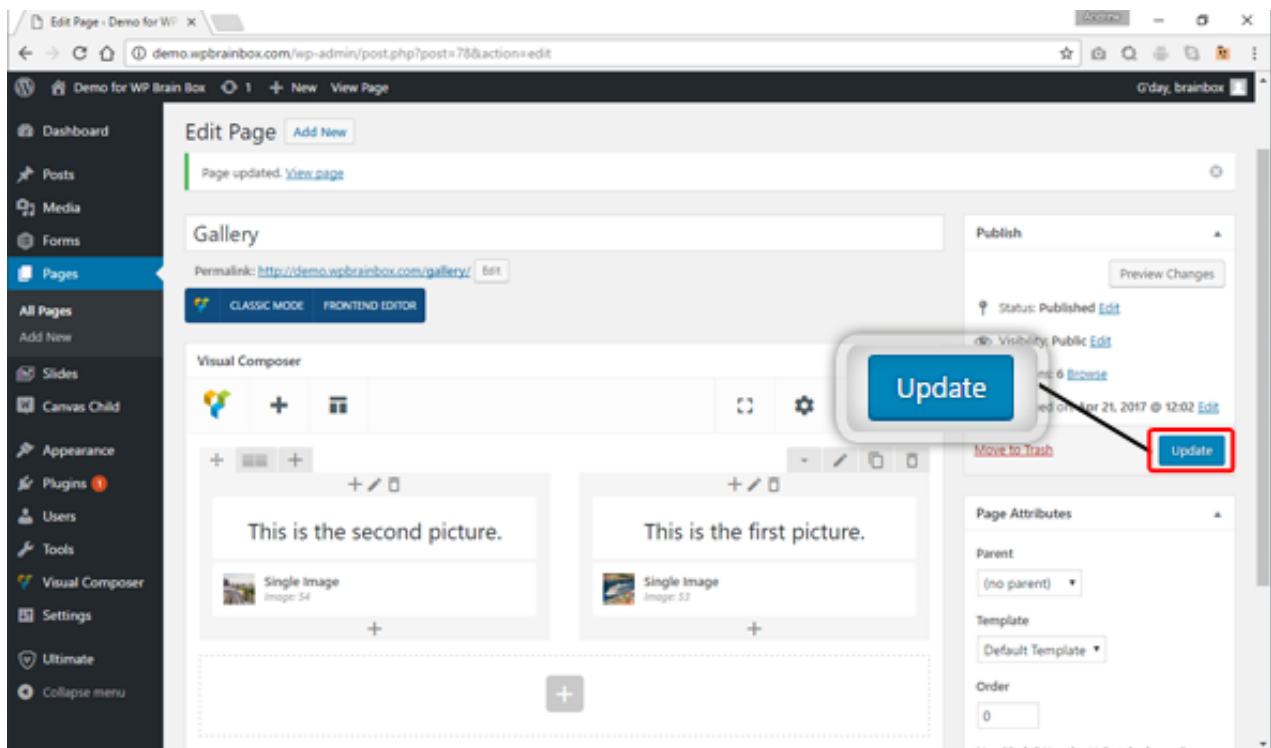
Let's go back to our back-end editor for the elements.

Step 2: Rearrange the elements in the column



Same process, you just need to click and drag the element and place it to where you want it to be seen in the column. As presented in the image above, we place the text block above the single image element.

Step 3: Update your page



To save your changes, click the Update button.
